RESOLUTION NO. 008 OF THE YEAR 2018

Councilman Edward S. Slicer offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

TITLE: RESOLUTION FOR A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE DIMINISHMENT AND ALTERATION OF THE HARPERSFIELD LIGHTING DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Harpersfield has received a petition dated November 14, 2017, requesting that the boundaries of the Town Lighting District be diminished and altered within the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Harpersfield believes that diminishment and alteration of the boundaries of the Town Lighting District is needed to limit the properties in the Lighting District to only those properties being served by the street lights and to accurately reflect only those parcels of property that benefit from and pay into the Lighting District; and

WHEREAS, New York State Town Law § 202-c provides that local entities may diminish and alter the boundaries of a town lighting district.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Harpersfield will hold a public hearing on the diminishment and alteration of the Town of Harpersfield Lighting District on August 14, 2018 at the Town Hall at 7:00 PM to consider said petition and hear all persons interested in the subject thereof concerning the same.

ALSO BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish a Notice for the Public Hearing in The Daily Star newspaper, located in Oneonta, New York and post a copy thereof on the sign-board of the Town, in the time and manner prescribed by law.
