RESOLUTION NO. 007 OF THE YEAR 2017

Councilman Robert Reeve Jr. offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

TITLE: RESOLUTION SCHEDULING A PUBLIC HEARING ON A PROPOSED LOCAL LAW TO AMEND LOCAL LAW NO. 001 OF THE YEAR 2006, THE TOWN OF HARPERSFIELD SITE PLAN REVIEW LOCAL LAW.

WHEREAS, Proposed Introductory Local Law No. 001 Of The Year 2017 entitled "A Local Law to Amend Local Law No. 001 of the Year 2006, the Town of Harpersfield Site Plan Review Local Law", was introduced at a meeting of the Town Board held on June 13, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the proposed local law would provide explicit authority for the Town of Harpersfield Code Enforcement Officer to issue appearance tickets for violations of the Site Plan Review Local Law and any orders or approvals issued under the Site Plan Review Local Law and to revise the penalty for violations to provide every person shall be deemed guilty of a separate offense for each day a violation, disobedience, omission, neglect or refusal shall continue.

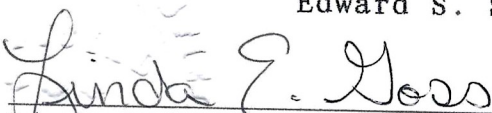

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish a notice of said public hearing in The Daily Star, and to post copies of such notice in the manner provided by law; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk and the Town Attorney are hereby authorized and directed to refer the proposed local law and notice of public hearing to the appropriate agencies for their review and recommendations.
