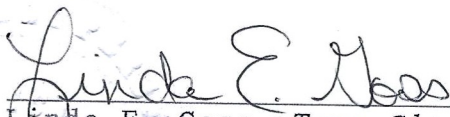
IN THE MATTER OF
THE REDUCTION OF TOWN JUSTICE POSITIONS FROM TWO TO ONE.

Resolution No. 006 of the Year 2016 having been adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Harpersfield, Delaware County, New York (the "Town") on January 12, 2016, The Town Board of the Town of Harpersfield duly adopted a resolution authorizing the reduction of town justice positions from two to one. Pursuant to Town Law § 60-a(1) such resolution was subject to a permissive referendum in the manner provided in Town Law Article 7. Since thirty days have elapsed since the posting and publication of the Notice of Permissive Referendum, the Town Clerk has filed a certificate certifying that no petition was filed requesting such referendum, it is hereby

ORDERED, that the Town Board of the Town of Harpersfield is authorized to reduce the number of town justice positions from two to one as described in Resolution No. 006 of the Year 2016 adopted by the Board on January 12, 2016.
