RESOLUTION NO.006 OF THE YEAR 2016

Councilman Edward S. Slicer offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

TITLE: RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF HARPERSFIELD TO REDUCE THE NUMBER OF TOWN JUSTICES FROM TWO TO ONE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to New York State Town Law §60-a (2) the Town Board of the Town of Harpersfield ("Town") has the authority to reduce the number of town justices from two (the number required by New York State Town Law §20(1) (a)) to one town justice; and


WHEREAS, the Town Board has determined that it is in the best interest of the Town to adopt this resolution that is subject to permissive referendum requirements.

THEREFORE, NOW, BE IT RESOLVED: the Town Board of the Town of Harpersfield does hereby reduce the number of town justices from two to one pursuant to a permissive referendum.
