RESOLUTION NO. 005 OF THE YEAR 2023

Councilmember Patrick F. Funk offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

TITLE: RESOLUTION BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF HARPERSFIELD ADOPTING A LOCAL LAW ENTITLED: "A LOCAL LAW TO ADOPT THE NEW YORK STATE MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR ENFORCEMENT OF THE NEW YORK STATE UNIFORM FIRE PREVENTION AND BUILDING CODE AND THE STATE ENERGY CONSERVATION CONSTRUCTION CODE".

WHEREAS, in the Matter of the Adoption of Local Law No. 001 of 2023 entitled "Local Law to Adopt the New York State Minimum Requirements for Enforcement of the New York State Uniform Fire Prevention and Building Code and the State Energy Conservation Construction Code"; and

WHEREAS, this Local Law is adopted pursuant to the authority granted in Section 10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law. Except as otherwise provided in the Uniform Code, the Energy Code or other State Law, or other Section of Local Law, all buildings, structures and premises, regardless of use or occupancy, are subject to the provisions of this Local Law.

WHEREAS, the Town Board adopted a resolution on December 15, 2022 scheduling a public hearing on the proposed Local Law for January 11, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing on the proposed Local Law was held on January 11, 2023 at the Town Hall; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board reviewed and considered all public comments received on the proposed Local Law; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Local Law was on file for inspection at the Town Clerk's office prior to the hearing and during the public review process; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF HARPERSFIELD, DELAWARE COUNTY, NEW YORK:

The Town Board of the Town of Harpersfield hereby adopts this Local Law to Adopt the New York State Minimum Requirements for Enforcement of the New York State Uniform Fire Prevention and Building Code and the State Energy Conservation Construction Code, being Local Law No. 001 of 2023, and the Town Clerk is hereby directed to file said Local Law with the Office of the Secretary of State in accordance with State Law.

Councilmember Erik R. Reeve seconded the motion and the resolution was put to a vote and recorded as follows:

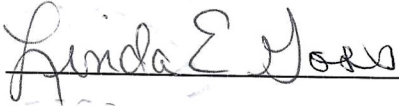
